1. IDENTIFICATION OF THE SUBSTANCE / PREPARATION AND OF THE COMPANY / UNDERTAKING

Product name: RAPID SETTING-POLYMER MODIFED-PATCH REPAIR

2. COMPOSITION / INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

Contains: A MIXTURE OF SILICA SANDS & CEMENTS.

Main hazards: Irritating to eyes, respiratory system and skin.

Skin contact: Wash with soap and water.
